PROTECTED AREAS NOTICE IN TERMS OF “REGULATIONS FOR THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION OF NATURE RESERVES, NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: PROTECTED AREAS ACT 57 OF 2003” (GAZETTE NO. 35021; 2012) AND “CITY OF CAPE TOWN: NATURE RESERVE BY-LAW (2020)”:

Please be advised that, as the Management Authority for False Bay Nature Reserve and according to **R6(1)(d)** and **R20(2)(a)(iii)** of the Regulations for the Proper Administration of Nature Reserves (GNR 99 of 8 February 2012) and Sections **6(1)(d)**, **12(2)(a)(iii)** and **12(2)(e)** of the City of Cape Town: Nature Reserve By-law (2020), **THE ZEEKOEVLEI WATERBODY** is hereby **OPEN** to all members of the public until further notice, with immediate effect.

The aquatic recreational area of Zeekoevlei is part of the False Bay Nature Reserve was closed in June 2021 as a result of faecal coliform counts exceeding those for safe recreational contact. Recent water quality tests show sufficient improvement to allow for intermediate recreational contact.

This opening applies to the Zeekoevlei water body of the False Bay Nature Reserve.

The opening of Zeekoevlei in the False Bay Nature Reserve is subject to any regulations imposed by the National State of Disaster with respect to the COVID 19 pandemic.
